

The line almost resembles clothing you'd wear to a holiday party in December, but some of the rich colors — plums, blues and reds — help make the line appropriate for the entire full season. Sophisticated and dressy but still fun and firty, all of these looks would work well for both office and cocktail parties.

The hits: The dressee, which are polyester but look almost like silk, will get you the most for your money (they're each \$49.99, on sale from \$79.0, and the gorycous loval patterns will have you looking like a walking carrass. Also, the jackets, perfect for layering over a dress, are stumning, and the allwer baukle jewelry (from \$12.00 to \$52.20) is sophisticated and beautiful. All of these styles look much more expensive.

The misses: The long-elecve T-shirt is a popular theme in the collection, and some of the floral designs, as well as the clingy rayou material, make them look a bit matrouly. Also — and this is a bummer — many of the cardigans have a shapeless baby-doll style and will look flattering only on the thin and smaller-chested.

Appropriate for what age? When high-end designers are saked to create afford-able collections for department stores. the times often end up geared toward teens and young women (such as the Jean Paul Gaultier and Zae Posen lines for Tar-get). But Simply Vera is sophisticated, and I think women of just about any age could pull it off.

Worth the buck? Other than the rayon T-shirts, definitely. The quality isn't near what you'd find at a high-end boutsque (polyester is used instead of silk), but it looks like it will hold well for a couple of seasons. Plus, the large discount certainly helpe!




